DUTIES & RESPONSIBILTIES:

Reporting to Manager of Maternal and Newborn Services, the successful candidate will be responsible for assessing, planning implementation and evaluating nursing care and practice activities in a multidisciplinary family centered care environment. Cross-training to Post-Partum required.

OUALIFCATIONS:

- * Registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario (in good standing);
- * Completion of a Perinatal Course or in process of completing (within two years of hire date) NOTE: an experienced perinatal nurse with two years of fulltime experience can challenge this course by writing the Canadian Nurses Association Perinatal Certification exam;
- * Current BCLS and NRP required;
- * Minimum 2-3 years in a Level II or III Birthing Suite is preferred with competency in advanced fetal monitoring, competency in epidural/spinal pain management and induction/augmentation of labour with oxytocin;
- * Experience in the scrub and circulating role for Caesarean births or enrolled in a Perioperative nursing course preferred;
- * Demonstrated commitment to maintain Reflective Practice Standards as outlined by the CNO;
- * Demonstrated effective organizational, problem-solving and teaching skills;
- * Effective communication and interpersonal skills;
- * Sound judgement, good observation and patient assessment skills, tact and empathy;
- * Demonstrated ability to assume a leadership/supervisory role;
